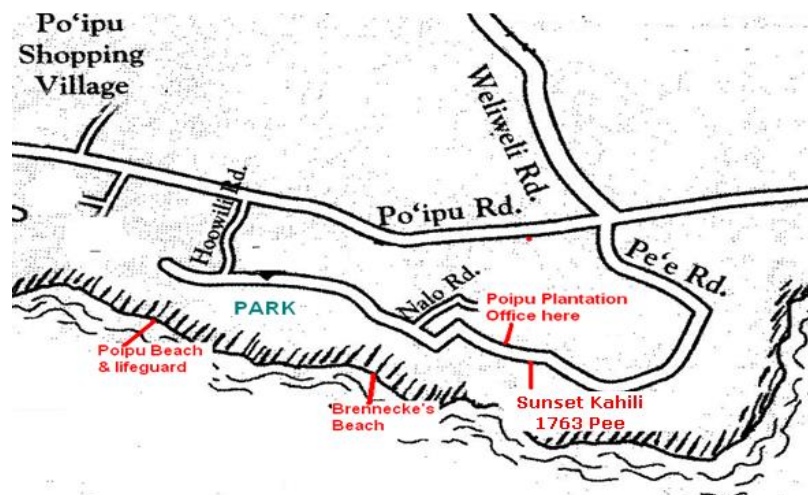

Aloha Sunset Suite Guests and welcome to Kauai.

We are your hosts while here at the Sunset Kahili, with our offices located across the street and downhill a few driveways walking toward Poipu Beach.

- **House and pool** guidelines for Sunset Kahili are included on a separate sheet for your information.
- **Poipu Plantation Office Hours:** 8 to 3 weekdays, to noon weekends and holidays.
- **CHECK IN:** If you have not yet, we ask that you stop by to check in, 8 to 3 weekdays and 8 to noon weekends at the Poipu Plantation Resort Office, walk downhill a 100 yards, on your right.
- **CHECK-OUT 11AM:** If you have checked in with our office, you are welcome to call 742-6757, let us know you are departing and leave the key there, housekeeping will be over.
- **Smoking** is not permitted on this property, Mahalo for your consideration.
- **Trash Room** is located next to the elevator. Please remove daily to avoid pests.
- **Telephone** is free of any charges. Dial all island calls and toll free, all incoming calls.
- **WiFi** is in your suite. Router name "sunset suites" or "sunset suites-ext" in 204. Pass is Poipu Plantation. a free unsecured connection is also on first floor recreation room "sunset kahili" if you are having trouble
- **Activity discounts and assistance:** We are at Poipu Plantation to share our knowledge and ideas about seeing Kauai and have maps, activity discounts, coolers, hiking books and other useful items for you to borrow. We are happy to go through the map anytime you are headed out and would like directions and ideas. We are also familiar with local and island wide walking and hiking trails.
- **Beach** is down the street (to left) and just around the corner, easy walk 200 yard walk. You may walk out from second floor, past elevator lobby, takes you to the sidewalk. First beach is Brennecke's with surf and walking along the park to Lifeguard station is a calm water swimming area. Poipu Beach goes from Brennecke's beach all the way west to the Sheraton. All coastlines are public in Hawaii.
- **Conserve Energy:** Being on this remote island, our utility costs are extremely high and resources limited. Please help us conserve when using the laundry and other electrical and water.
- **Groceries:** Stores are available at the traffic circle; turn right on Poipu Road and immediately on left is Kukuiula Store, a medium size. Continuing on Poipu Road in our town of Koloa, right at gas station on Koloa road is Sueoka's on right, and further up the street on right is Big Save open to 10.
- **Restaurants:** If you have just arrived, down the street to Beach Park is Brennecke's Beach broiler open serving until 9. Further up Poipu Road (west) to Poipu Shopping Village is Keoki's open to 10. Please refer to the white restaurant guide magazine or feel free to stop by our office for more suggestions.
- **Housekeeping / cleaning:** Final cleaning is included. Please wash dishes and other kitchen items and remove trash. We will take care of everything else (linens and general cleaning) Cleaning supplies are also in the closet for your convenience. **Optional Housekeeping:** with 24 hour notice 742-6757.



Guest Medical and Emergency Information

Poipu Plantation Resort, our 24 hour emergency phone is 652-2063 (dial 1+808 from out of area phone)

Telephone use:

The in suite telephone is free to use. It will call all Kauai numbers by dialing 7 digits only (xxx-xxxx). In coming and toll free calls are also no charge. All other calls will not work.

Emergency information – dial 911 on your suite telephone if you have a medical or fire emergency

If you have a medical or fire emergency, please dial 911 on your suite or common area telephone. Your address is Sunset Kahili, 1763 Pee Road, nearest cross street is Hooahu Road. Please stand in the front to direct respondents. If time allows, please call our after hour number after 911 so that we may assist (1-808) 652-2063.

Tsunami Warning (Tidal wave warning).

Audible Sirens: the first Monday of each month is a test of our Tsunami warning system sirens. There is no need to be alarmed when you hear it at that time.

If Sirens sound other than test day, it is an alert to turn on your Television and find out what the emergency is. Time may be of the essence if it is a local Hawaii wave. Our staff will be here or in route, since we receive a pre-warning of the siren by telephone (if time allowed).

You may evacuate to the 4th or higher floor. You may also come across to the Poipu Plantation Resort since we are not in the inundation zone. If you wish to evacuate, Civil Defense wants you to walk, not drive cars. To leave the area and not come to Poipu Plantation, walk right (uphill), out of the resort and left at the first street. At stop sign, left again to the other side of Poipu road to a higher elevation. Sirens continue every few minutes until the emergency has passed. There is no all clear siren. If you evacuate, you will be delayed many hours before they will let you return.

Medical Needs

Our nearest Doctor office is Kauai Medical in our town of Koloa (5 minutes). They are open normal business hours, Monday through Friday at 742-1621 for appointments or walk in information.

Other hours, you must proceed to Wilcox Hospital in Lihue, 3-3420 Kuhio Hwy. It is located on Hwy 50, just past Wal Mart. Simply take Hwy 50, stay on that street through Lihue business district until you pass Wal Mart and then the hospital on your right. They have a walk in clinic and emergency room. 245-1532.

Pharmacy Needs

Life Way Pharmacy is closest to us up in Koloa town, Poipu Road to the Gas Station, turn right and it is on the right. They are open weekdays to 5 and Saturday to 1. 742-7511.

Long's Drugs is next closest, open weekends and evenings also. It is in Lihue at the Kukui Grove shopping center where Macy's is located. 245-7771
